I keep explaining to her that once a case is in the hands of lawyers there is little we can do other than offer pastoral support. She has yet to sign a waiver, yet they are receiving counseling. However they are explaining it to Dr. Doherty, he has not sent any bills because of the waiver. I am going to speak to Wilson Rogers about his interaction with their lawyer. There is some problem in regard to the Tolling Agreement.

kept telling me that Father Higgins said these words to her after he interviewed . "I believe her. It happened." She also said that one time when she spoke to Father Scanlan that he told her that he had been accused before and it proved to be untrue. Richard wonders why Cardinal Law doesn't call them to express his concern for them.

Even though BOS-03 previously gave me telephone number, she asked that I not call her for awhile. thinks she might get upset again. They are all pretending nothing happened, although they are going for counseling. She asked that they be able to go twice a week. I said that would be fine for now. I also told her to tell the doctor to send the bills to me, rather than let them pile up. I'll clarify the signing of the waiver with the lawyers.

BOS-03 really wants to know where Father is and what the diocese is doing about his behavior. She said that she can't be sure but she thinks she has seen him riding around town. This makes her nervous, especially in regard to . Is she safe?
